The funds shall be subject to the following conditions:-

The funds shall be utilized as per Approved work Plan 2015-16.

Cooperative Societies shall ensure that project wise accounts are maintained and are subject to
pass of statutory Audit, an inventory of the assets created under the projects be preserved and
the no longer required shall be transferred to the Nodal department for its use and re-deployment,
if possible.

Expenditure towards maintenance of assets, Salary, Transport, POL, TA/DA, Purchase of Vehicle, Foreign
including study tours of farmers abroad and other consumables shall not be incurred out of RKVY.
Expenses towards Hiring of Manpower on outsourcing/Contractual basis can be met within 1%
of the total amount earmarked for administrative expenses with the approval of SLSC. This amount shall be considered
only after receiving proper proposal and shall include DPR preparation.

For awareness camps/demonstration/publicity, the department shall utilize the funds out of
under Support to State Extension Programmes for Extension Reforms (ATMA) as per the guidelines
of the Government of India.


Cooperative Societies shall implement the programme/activities/components on the costs
of the lines/subsidy component at par which are admissible/missible in the normal Centrally
Sponsored Scheme implemented by the departments for RKVY Plan during 2014-15.

Cooperative Societies shall ensure that funds released are utilized prudently and judiciously and
they should book the expenditure just for the sake of spending.

Cooperative Societies shall restrict the expenditure to the actual availability of funds and **no
liability shall be created in any case.**

Expenditure shall be incurred only after observing all codal formalities required under rules.

Cooperative Societies shall ensure that there is no overlapping /duplication in adoption
of expenditure from any other scheme of State or Central Govt.


